Display

All indicators, except for the clock time indicator, are displayed by pressing the

a Transmission mark

This transmission mark (▲) indicates when the remote controller transmits signals to the indoor unit.

b Mode indicator

Indicates the current operation mode.

(AUTO: Automatic control, A: Auto changeover control, : HEAT)

c Temperature indicator

Indicates the temperature setting (17°C to 30°C).

d PURE indicator

Shows that the electrical air-purifying operation is in progress.

Display

① Transmission mark

This transmission mark (▲) indicates when the remote controller transmits signals to the indoor unit.

② Mode indicator

Display
