<u>Page 13</u> The Volume Control increases or decreases the audio level. Using your mouse, move the slider up and down to adjust the volume. Click the Mute Sound button to mute the audio. To turn the audio on, click the Mute Sound button again. Mute Sound button slider ASUS 740DVD...

Page 14: Standard Buttons

Page 24 DVD-ROM drive. DVD Station will automatically search for all available DVD files on the selected drive. A DVD information file VTS_01_0.IFO (for a DVD-Video disc) should appear on the Title List. Click OK to close the dialog. Click the PLAY button on the DVD station. ASUS 740DVD...

Page 25 If the 10-key keypad is hidden by another window, clicking the 10-key Keypad butagain will bring it back to the foreground. During full-screen video playback, use the right mouse button to hide and unhide the 10-key keypad. ASUS 740DVD...

Page 26: Video Cd Playback

Station will show a series of number buttons on the screen next to the Standard Buttons. Use these buttons to make your selection. Click on the number that you want to select. The number will be displayed in the display panel. ASUS 740DVD...
