Page 4: Introduction

Introduction This owner's manual applies to models 32A41 and 36A41, and there are slight differences between them. Model 32A41 is used in this manual for illustration purposes. Instructions in this manual are based on using the buttons on the remote control.

Page 5: Connecting Your Tv

S-video cables instead of regular video cables. – For BEST picture quality: If your equipment has component video connections (ColorStream[™] is Toshiba's brand), use component video cables instead of regular or S-video cables. Component video cables come in sets of three.

Page 6: Connecting A Cable Converter Box And A Vcr

Connecting your TV Connecting a cable converter box and a VCR This connection allows you to watch videotapes and watch and record basic and premium cable channels. Tune the TV and VCR channels to 3 or 4 (whichever channel is vacant in your area), and then use the converter box to change channels. You will need: •...

Page 7: Connecting A Dvd Player With Component Video And A Vcr

Connecting a DVD player with component video and a VCR This connection allows you to watch DVD, VCR, and TV programs, and record TV programs. Your TV has ColorStream (component video) connections. Connecting your TV to a component video–compatible DVD player (such as a Toshiba DVD player with ColorStream ™...

Page 8: Preparing The Remote Control For Use

If you have a Toshiba VCR, your TV remote control is already programmed to operate it (see page 10). If you have a non-Toshiba VCR and/or cable TV converter, you must first program your remote control so it will operate the other equipment (see pages 11–13).

Page 9: Location Of Controls On Tv And Remote Control

Page 10: Using The Remote Control With A Vcr Or Cable Tv Converter

Page 11: Programming The Remote Control For Use With A Non-Toshiba Vcr Or Cable Tv Converter

VCR or cable TV converter Your Toshiba TV remote control is preprogrammed to operate Toshiba brand VCRs and cable TV converters. To program your TV remote control to operate a non-Toshiba VCR or a cable TV converter, follow these steps:...

<u>Page 12</u> VCR or cable TV converter In some rare cases, you may not be able to operate your non-Toshiba equipment with your TV remote control. Your other equipment may use a code that is not recognized by the TV remote control. If this happens, you will need to use the remote control provided with your other equipment.

Page 14: Menu Function (General Instructions)

Page 16: Programming The Channel Memory

Programming the channel memory The channel memory is the list of TV channels your TV stops on when you press CHANNEL L/M. First, use the TV/CABLE and CH PROGRAM functions (below) to program all active channels in your area into the channel memory.

Page 17: Add/Erase Function

ADD/ERASE function After using the CH PROGRAM function to automatically program channels into the channel memory, you can use the ADD/ERASE function to manually add or erase individual channels, as follows: Select the channel you want to add or erase. If you are adding a channel, you must use the Channel Number buttons to select the channel.

Page 20: Adjusting The Picture

Page 21: Selecting The Color Temperature

Selecting the color temperature The color temperature modes change the color tones of the picture. Press MENU until the Picture 2 menu is displayed on-screen. Press t or s until COLOR TEMPERATURE is displayed in purple. Press T or S until the desired mode is displayed in purple.

Page 22: Adjusting The Sound

Page 23: Using The Off-Timer (Sleep Timer)

Page 24: Selecting Stereo/Sap Broadcasts

Selecting stereo/SAP broadcasts The MTS (multi-channel TV sound) feature has the following functions: • Stereo Sound: Select either high fidelity stereo sound or monaural (mono) sound. • SAP: Activate the SAP (second audio program), which replaces the regular audio with a second language or other information (when provided by individual stations).

Page 25: Listening To A Second Audio Program (Sap)

Listening to a second audio program (SAP) When the TV receives an SAP broadcast (typically a second language), "SAP" displays on-screen every time you turn the TV on, change the channel, or press RECALL. To activate the SAP feature(when provided by individual stations): Press MENU until the Audio menu is displayed on-screen.

Page 26: Using The Favorite Channel Programming Feature

Using the favorite channel programming feature The Favorite Channel Programming feature allows you to program up to 12 channels into the favorite channel memory. Once programmed, press the FAV CH t/s buttons on the remote control to scan through your favorite channels only, skipping other channels you do not normally view.

Page 27: Using The Closed Caption Feature

Using the closed caption feature The closed caption feature has two options: captions or text. A caption is a printed version of the dialogue, narration, and/or sound effects of a program.Text is information not related to the program (such as stock or weather reports) that appears on-screen (when provided by individual stations).

Page 28: Using The V-Chip Control Feature

Using the V-CHIP control feature Some TV programs and movies include signals that classify the content of the program (violence, sex, dialog, language). The V-CHIP (parental) control feature detects the signals and blocks the programs according to your selections. POWER RECALL MUTE RECALL...

Page 29: Adjusting The V-Chip Control Menu

Unblocking programs temporarily If you try to watch a TV program that exceeds the rating limits you set, the TV will enter into the program block mode. THIS PROGRAM HAS BEEN BLOCKED! TV-PG EXCEEDS SET LIMITS PUSH MUTE TO ENTER PIN If you want to watch the blocked program temporarily, press MUTE.
