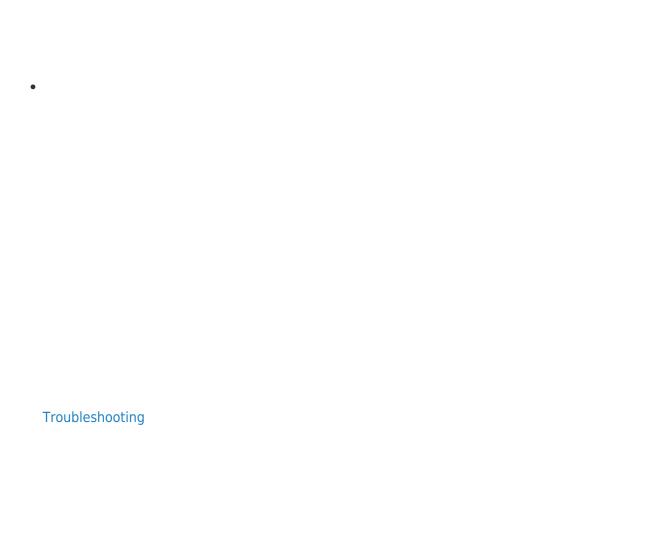





Page 7: Selecting A Location For The Tv

Your TV's ColorStream video) inputs are color-coded in the same manner as the cables. NOTE REGARDING PICTURE QUALITY When connecting video equipment to your Toshiba TV: ● For GOOD picture quality: Use a standard yellow video cable.

Page 8: Connecting A Vcr

Connecting a VCR This connection allows you to watch local channels and video programs, play or record on the VCR while watching TV, and record from one channel while watching another channel. From antenna or Cable IN from ANT OUT to TV CH 3 CH 4 Back of TV...

Page 9: Connecting A Dvd Player Or Satellite Receiver And A Vcr

Page 11: Connecting A Camcorder

Page 15: Adding And Erasing Channels Manually

7. Press x or • to start automatically channel programming (CH PROGRAM window appears on-screen). The TV automatically cycles through every TV or cable channel (depending on which you selected), and stores all active channels in the TV's memory. Press MENU to stop on the way. Page 16: Using The Tv's Features

Using the TV's features Programming your favorite channels The favorite channel feature allow you to use the FAV yz buttons on the remote control to cycle through your favorite channels, skipping over channels you do not normally watch. You can program a maximum of 12 favorite channels.

Page 17: Using The V-Chip Feature

Using the V-CHIP feature You can use the V-Chip feature to block certain programs or channels, to prevent others from viewing them. Selecting a PIN code Before you can block programs or channels, you must select a personal identification number(PIN)code. Your PIN code allows you to access the V-Chip menu, and prevents others from changing the rating and blocking limits you set.

Page 18: Blocking Programs By Ratings

Blocking programs by ratings The Motion Picture Association of America (MPAA) uses a rating system to qualify motion picture content. Television broadcasters employ a similar rating system to qualify the content of television programs. The TV and MPAA ratings work with the V-Chip feature to allow you to block access to programs that exceed the rating limits you set.

Page 22: Selecting The Video Input Source

Selecting the video input source You can use the VIDEO1 or VIDEO 2 buttons on the remote control to view a signal coming from other devices, such as VCRs or video disc players that may be connected to your TV. (see "Connecting your TV" on page 8.) Or press the TV/VIDEO button on the TV repeatedly to select VIDEO1, VIDEO2 or TV.

Page 23: Using The Closed Caption Feature

Using the closed caption feature The closed caption feature has two options: • Captions—An onscreen display of the dialogue, narration, and sound effects of TV programs and videos that are closed captioned (usually marked as "CC" in TV listings). • Text—An on-screen display of information not related to the current program, such as weather or stock data (when provided by individual stations).

Page 24: Setting The Sleep Timer

Setting the sleep timer To set the sleep timer to turn the TV off (standby mode) automatically: 1. Press SLEEP to set the length of time until the TV turns off. Every time you press the button,

Page 25: Selecting Stereo/Sap Broadcasts

Selecting stereo/SAP broadcasts The multi-channel TV sound (MTS) feature allows you to listen to high-fidelity stereo sound while watching TV. MTS can also transmit a second audio program (SAP) containing a second language, music, or other audio information (when provided by individual stations). When the TV receives a stereo or SAP broadcast, the word STEREO or SAP appears on-screen every time the TV is turned on, the channel is changed, or the RECALL button is pressed.

Page 26: Using The Wow (Sound Effect) Feature

Using the WOW (sound effect) feature WOW is a special combination of SRS audio technologies that creates a thrilling surround sound experience with deep rich bass from a mono or stereo sound sources. Your audio now sounds fuller, richer and wider. Based on the elements of the flagship SRS 3D technology, WOW restores the spatial cues and ambient information that is lost during standard stereo playback.
