## Using the auto format

When the TV receives a true HDMI signal picture and the auto format is On, it will automatically be displayed in HDMI signal format, irrespective of the TV's previous setting.

### Using the auto format

## Selecting the video view

1 Press and hold **⊕** or press the video input mode list **P▼** or **P▲** to select appropriate the TV right side panel or repeatedly to select required

to select On or Off.

## Activating blue screen

With the blue screen function On, the screen will automatically turn blue and the sound will be muted when no signal is being received.

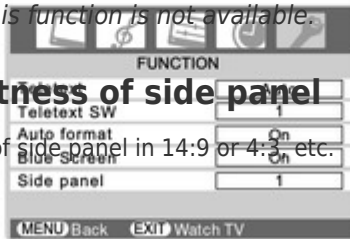
### 1 Using the auto format

From the FUNCTION menu, press < or > to select Blue screen.

2 Press Y or y to select On or Off.

Note: 1 Press , then press or to display the FUNCTION menu.

In the PC input mode, double-window mode (- page 23) or teletext mode (- page 21), this function is not available.



### Adjusting the brightness of side panel

You can adjust the brightness of side panel in 14:9 or 4:3, etc. mode.

1 From the FUNCTION menu, press or to select Auto format, then press or to select Side panel.

### 2 Activating blue screen

Press Y or y to adjust the settings as required.

20 Using the TV's features

1 From the FUNCTION menu, press or to select Blue screen.

2 Press or to select On or Off.

Note: In the PC input mode, double-window mode (page 23) or teletext mode (page 21), this function is not available.

## 1 Selecting the video input source to view

### Adjusting the brightness of side panel

Press and hold or press on the remote control until the video input mode list appears on the screen, then press < or > to select appropriate input source (or press the TV right side panel or on the remote control repeatedly to select required input source directly).

OK: 1 From the FUNCTION menu, press or to select Side panel.

2 Press or to adjust the settings as required.
