Page 7: Drying Tips

Drying tips The dryer does not heat when the Temperature Selector is set on FLUFF AIR. This setting can be used to fluff bedding, plastic tablecloths, foam rubber pillows, stuffed toys, snea kers, etc. Turn the Temperature Selector FLUFF AIR. Turn the Control Knob to the number of minutes you want in the...

Page 8: Lint Screen

Lint screen Clean the lint screen before each increase drying time and may be a FIRE HAZARD. Open the lid and pull the lint screen straight out. Lint removal Lint can gather inside the dryer and create should be removed every 2 to 3 years, dryer...

Page 9: Caring For Your Dryer

Caring for your dryer Remove sharp objects from clothing before drying - pins, buckles, etc. Close metal zippers. Wipe off all spills with a damp,soft cloth. Spills allowed to remain dull or damage the finish. Non-colorfast items can stain the drum.
