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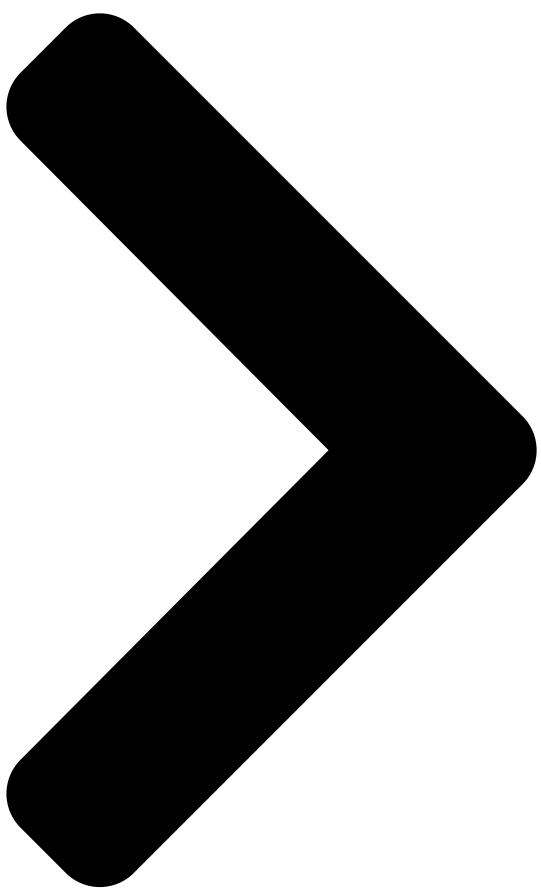

Detach bottom of grille from cabinet mounting pins. Lift cabinet from base. 3. Remove filter from back of rear grille: Gently pull top of filter toward you until tabs release from grille.
