

Page 7: Loading Your Dishwasher

Loading Your Dishwasher This section tells how to proper& load your dishwasher for best washing and rinsing results. Preparing to load the dishwasher To save water and energy, do not rinse diis before putting them into the dishwasher. Remove large pieces of food, bones, and other hard items.

Page 8 Loading the bottom Load items with cooked-on or dried-on food in the bottom rack, with soiled surfaces facing inward to the spray. Mixed load Load plates, soup bowls, etc., between prongs and facing inward to the spray. Make sure pot handles and other items do not stop rotation of the spray arm.

<u>Page 9</u> Loading the top rack Load the top rack with cups, glasses, and smaller items. Do not cover the third level wash (on some models) when loading the top rack. Cup and glass load Load so open ends face down for cleaning and draining.
