





Page 5: Lighting Standing Pilots

Page 6: The Oven Vent

Page 7: Caring For Youi Range

Hold cooktop up securely with one hand. Models FGC355V, FGP355V, NOTE: FGP345V, FGP335V, FLP330V, FGP325V, FLP320V & FGP320V have removable cooktops. For these models, lift cooktop completely off.

Page 8: The Standard-Cleaning

Some can become trapped in the porcelain surface and give off harmful fumes. (Models FGC355V, FGP355V WINDOW & FGP345V) - Keep clean with warm soapy water or spray glass cleaner. Use a plastic scouring pad for heavily-soiled areas.
