

MUTE turns the sound on and off. TV selects TV antenna as the input signal. AV1/AV2 selects the AV input signal from one of these connectors.

appear. Screen jumps crazily or is very unstable. This is commonly the result of car ignition noise interference, neon lights, or other forms of electrical interference.
