<u>Page 12</u> Status Indicators Battery Charge Indicator The battery charge indicator (LED) shows the battery charging status as follows: Powered ON / Standby mode High battery power (95%–100%) Medium battery power (10%–94%) Low battery power (0%–10%) Powered OFF High battery power (95%–100%) Medium battery power (11%–94%) Low battery power...

<u>Page 13</u> Touchpad and Buttons The touchpad and its buttons comprises a pointing device that provides the same functions as a desktop mouse. Multi-finger gesture input is available to allow easy web and document navigation. ASUS Eee PC...

Page 14: Bottom Side

Bottom Side Refer to the diagram below to identify the components on this side of the Eee PC. The bottom side may vary in appearance depending on model. The bottom of the Eee PC can get very hot. Be careful when handling the Eee PC while it is in operation or recently been in operation.

Page 15: Front Side

The built-in stereo speaker system allows you to hear audio without additional attachments. The multimedia sound system features an integrated digital audio controller that produces rich, vibrant sound (results improved with external stereo headphones or speakers). Page 16: Right Side

Right Side Refer to the diagram below to identify the components on this side of the Eee PC. Page 21: Touchpad Usage

Page 22 Two-finger scrolling up/down or left/right- Use two fingertips to slide up/down or left/right on the touchpad to scroll a window up/down or left/ right.
