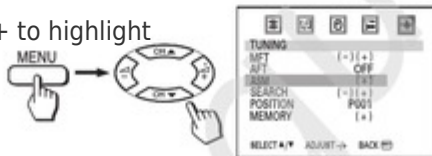

Presetting channel

• Use the SEARCH function if desired channels cannot be preset with the ASM or if you would like to preset channels to specific position numbers one by one.

To use the SEARCH function

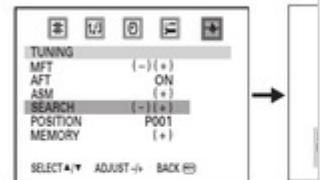

Press MENU and then ; +/- to highlight the "TUNING" icon.

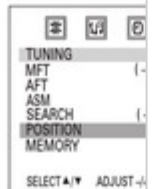
Press CH ▲/▼ to select "SEARCH". Pressing ; -/+ to highlight the "TUNING" icon. Select "ASM", then press ; + to start the search. When the TV screen returns to the start position, the procedure is complete.



Repeat this process until the desired channel is shown.

When the desired channel is shown, press CH ▲/▼ to select "POSITION". Press ; + repeatedly until the position number is shown.

Press CH ▲/▼ to select "MEMORY". Press ; + to memorize the channel and press ; -/+ to cancel.

Repeat this process until you can get the desired channel.

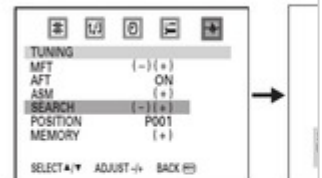
