

<u>Page 9</u> INSTALLATION Level Adjusting • Once in its permanent operating position, check that the dryer is absolutely level with the aid of a spirit level. If it is not, adjust the feet with a tool. Note! if dryer could not be placed horizontally (the lean angle is no more than 2°, the dryer will work unbalanced or stop working sometimes.

Page 11: Before Each Drying

OPERATIONS Before Each Drying 1.Before drying, thoroughly spin the laundry in washing machine. High spin speed can reduce the drying time and save energy consumption. 2.For uniform drying result, sort the laundry according to fabric type and drying programme. 3.Before drying, please close zips, hooks and eyelets, button up, tie fabric belts, etc. 4.Do not over dry the clothes, because over dried clothes can easily get creases.

Page 12: Control Panel

OPERATIONS Control Panel Display On/Off This display shows the setting, estimated Product is switched on or off. remaining time and status messages of your dryer. Start/Pause Press the button to start or pause the Programmes drying cycle. Different Dryer cycle can be selected according to the user's needs to make the Option clothes have more effective drying results.

Page 13 OPERATIONS Option INTENSVIE Press the button to select adjust the dryness level of the laundry. The level has three grades . The drying time increases 3 minutes in every grade. 1.The intensity function can be activated only before the programme start. 2.Press the INTENSVIED button repeatedly to select the drying time.
