<u>Page 5</u> SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS • The new hose-sets supplied with the appliance must be used and the old hose-sets must not be used. • Before maintenance, unplug the appliance. • Always unplug the machine and turn off the water supply after use. The standard inlet water pressure: 0.05MPa~1MPa.

<u>Page 6</u> SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS • Pull out its plug from the power socket before cleaning or maintenance. • Do not use any socket with rated current less than that of appliance. Never pull out power plug with wet hand. • Please remember to disconnect water and power supply immediately after the clothes are washed.

#### Page 16: Operations

OPERATIONS Quick Start Caution! • Before washing, please make sure it's installed properly. • Before washing at first time, the washing machine shall be operated in one round of the whole procedures without clothes in as follows. The suggested program is "DRUM CLEAN". 1.

Page 17 OPERATIONS Select function or default • TEMP./ SPIN/ RINSE/SENSEDOSE Press the button (TEMP./ SPIN/ RINSE/SENSEDOSE) to adjust the parameter. • DELAY END/ FAST WASH/ DRYING Step1: Press the button( DELAY END/ FAST WASH/ DRYING) Step2: Slide and touch OK to select different level as you need.

#### Page 18: Before Each Washing

OPERATIONS Before Each Washing • The working condition of the washer should be(0-40)  $^{\circ}$ C .If used under 0  $^{\circ}$ C ,the inlet valve and draining system may be damaged. If the machine is placed under condition of 0  $^{\circ}$ C or less, then it should be transferred to normal ambient temperature to ensure the water supply hose and drain hose are not frozen before use.

#### Page 19: Detergent Dispenser

OPERATIONS Detergent Dispenser  $\approx$  Liquid detergent (MAX: 810ml) Softener (MAX: $\approx$ 440ml) If you want to use powder detergent ,you can add it directly into the drum with clothes by using the container. Please put the container on the top of the load to make powder well dissolved. Don't choose "Auto"or"...
