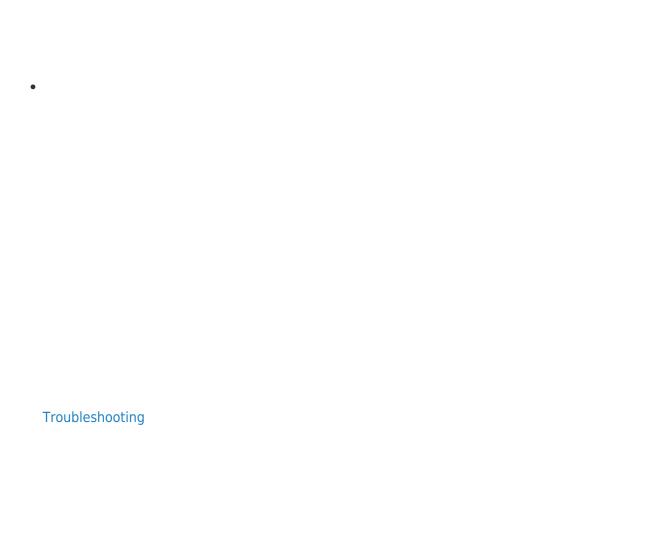

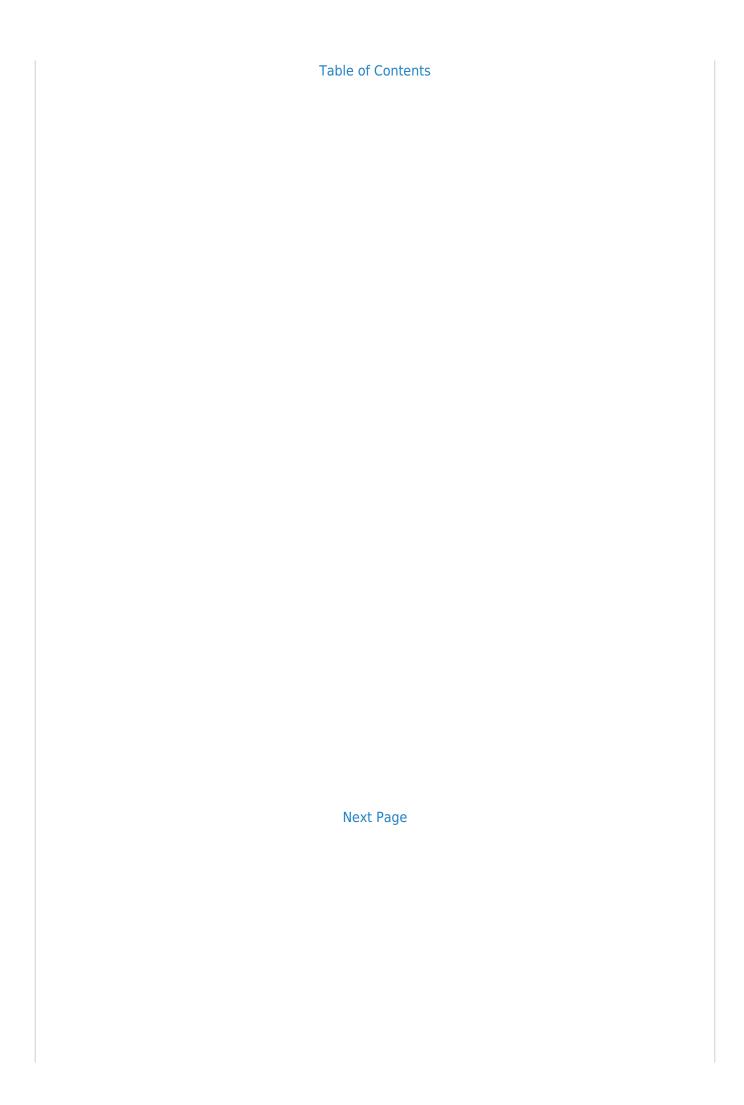

#### Page 4: Precautions

#### Page 7: Cleaning

CLEANING Be sure to unplug the appliance from the power supply. 1. Clean the cavity of the oven after using with a slightly damp cloth. 2. Clean the accessories in the usual way in soapy water. 3. #### Page 8: Utensils

<u>Page 10</u> Countertop Installation Remove all packing material and accessories. Examine the oven for any damage such as dents or broken door. Do not install if oven is damaged. Cabinet: Remove any protective film found on the microwave oven cabinet surface. Do not remove the light brown Mica cover that is attached to the oven cavity to protect the magnetron.

#### Page 11: Control Panel

#### Page 12: Operation

OPERATION MICROWAVE POWER LEVEL\* 11 power levels are available. Press "POWER" to select Level 10. Press the digit on the Control Panel to select Level 9 to 0. When you select "PL0", there is no power, only FAN will work to remove odor in the cabinet. Level Power 100%...

#### Page 13: Express Cook

EXPRESS COOK (1) In waiting state, instant cooking at 100% power level can be started by select a cooking time from 1 to 6 minutes by pressing number pads 1 to 6. Press "START/+30SEC." to increase the cooking time. The maximum cooking time is 99 minutes and 99 seconds.

#### Page 14: Multi-Stage Cooking

• FROZEN VEGETABLE (a) Press "FROZEN VEGETABLE" repeatedly until the number you wish appears in the display, "150", "350", "500" grams will display in order. For example, press "FROZEN VEGETABLE" once, "150" appears. (b) Press "START/+30SEC." to cook, buzzer sounds once. When cooking finishes, buzzer sounds five times and then turn back to waiting state.

#### Page 15: Lock Function For Children

LOCK FUNCTION FOR CHILDREN Lock: In waiting state, press "STOP/CANCEL" for 3 seconds, there will be a long "beep" denoting the entering into the children-lock state; meanwhile, screen will display " ". Lock quitting: In locked state, press "STOP/CANCEL" for 3 seconds, there will be a long "beep" denoting that lock is released.

#### Page 16: Trouble Shooting

TROUBLE SHOOTING Normal Radio and TV reception may be interfered when microwave oven operating. Microwave oven interfering TV It is similar to the interference of small electrical appliance, like mixer, vacuum reception cleaner, and electric fan. It is normal. Dim oven light In low power microwave cooking, oven light may become dim.
