Summary of Contents for Sanyo DP42746

Page 1: Dvd Player Connection

Press the POWER key. First Please connect all signals and antennas to jacks and terminals on the back of the TV. Then press the Channel UP key. Press EXIT key to cancel setup. Initial On-Screen Display Press the CH L (channel up) key to start INPUT All Channel Search.

Page 2: Positioning Precautions

DTV. For best viewing, avoid locating the DTV where direct sunlight or indoor lighting falls on the screen. NOTE: The optimum viewing distance of your new Sanyo Wide Screen Plasma DTV is 8.75 feet. Allow adequate space for proper ventilation (3 to 4 inches on the sides, top, and back).
