To control the audio:

1 Turn on the TV and the external analog audio amplifier.

2 Minimize the sound volume on the external analog audio amplifier's remote control.

Turn on the TV and the stereo amplifier.
Minimize the sound volume from the TV's built-in speakers and control the volume level using the amplifier's remote control.
