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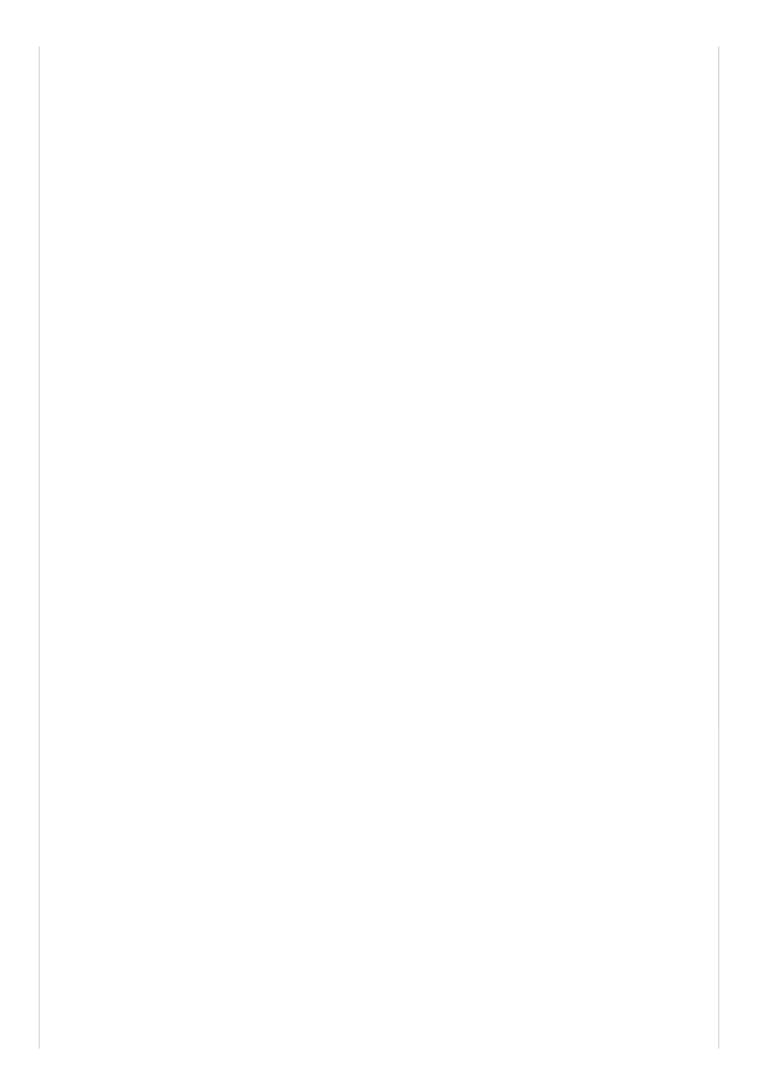
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

Page 13 Assembly Notice Please be sure to pull out adapter and disconnect the battery. When installing the SSD, please keep the SSD less then 15 degrees When installing the SSD, please follow the steps below. with motherboard, and then insert the SSD. Align and insert the new M.2 card into the module slot.

Page 14 Disassembly Notice Please be sure to pull out adapter and disconnect the battery. Step 1: Unlock and remove the RAM module. Assembly Notice Align and insert the new RAM module at 30° into the memory slot. Once properly inserted, push down the RAM module until it clicks in place. °...

M2\*4L D4.6 (K) W-NI NY 2.0±0.2 Recommend that the force point is at green block, and pull up thermal module to take it out.

<u>Page 23</u> KEYBOARD MODULE Disassembly Notice Please be sure to pull out adapter and disconnect the battery. Step 1: Disconnect and remove the (orange mark) FP FFC. Torque (kgf-cm) Screws Spec Step 2: Disconnect and remove the (yellow mark) TP FFC. Step 3: Lift up (red mark) KB FFC and TP CONDUCTIVE TAPE.

Page 24 KEYBOARD MODULE & TOUCHPAD MODULE Assembly Notice Please be sure to pull out adapter and disconnect the battery. Please follow the below notice when assembling the Keyboard module & Touchpad module. If FFC is damage during disassembly, please replace new one. Please paste the new TP CONDUCTIVE TAPE\*1pc if you need to change the Here are some samples of FFC damage: touchpad module and keyboard module.

<u>Page 25</u> LCD BEZEL Disassembly Notice Please be sure to pull out adapter and disconnect the battery. Step 1: Use the plastic blade to insert holes at both ends of the hinge cap then pry open. Step 2: Remove the hinge cap. Step  $3-1\sim3-3$ , Start from the middle area of each side of bezel, Step 3: Remove LCD BEZEL.

Page 26 LCD PANEL Disassembly Notice Please be sure to pull out adapter and disconnect the battery. Step 1: Release the (yellow mark) tape then remove (red & green mark) screws\*10pcs. Screws Spec Torque (kgf-cm) Step 2: Remove hinges\*2pcs. M2.5\*2.5L K B-ZN #1 NY Step 3: Pull out LCD adhesives\*2pcs.

Page 27 LCD PANEL & OLCD BKT Disassembly Notice Please be sure to pull out adapter and disconnect the battery. Step 1 : Pull the (red mark) adhesive(\*4pcs) up about 30 degree slowly. Step 2 : Separate the Panel and OLCD BKT carefully. Don't pull out the tape in vertical direction!  $\square$ ...

<u>Page 28</u> LCD COVER Disassembly Notice Please be sure to pull out adapter and disconnect the battery. Step 1: Disconnect and remove CAMERA. Step 2: Remove MIC RUBBER\*2pcs. Step 3: Remove ACETATE TAPE and EDP CABLE. Disconnect Release ACETATE TAPE MIC RUBBE Back...

<u>Page 29</u> LCD COVER Assembly Notice Please be sure to pull out adapter and disconnect the battery. Please follow the red marks to tidy up the EDP CABLE as illustrated. Remember to paste the ACETATE tape that comes with the LCD cover to fix the EDP cable as illustrated.

Page 30 LCD MODULE Assembly Notice Please be sure to pull out adapter and disconnect the

battery. OLED PANEL, before assembling the LCD module, please note the alignment rubber of the OLED BKT, and LCD COVER as illustrated. Back...

<u>Page 31</u> LCD PANEL & OLCD BKT Assembly Notice Please be sure to pull out adapter and disconnect the battery. Please choose the new corresponding ADHESIVE with the Panel when assembling the LCD module. When reuse the LCD PANEL: (The following is an operation example) Please use the fingertip to clean the residual glue on PANEL or BEZEL.
