

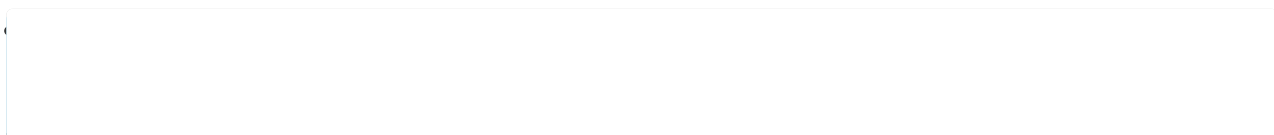

System Setting

You can select the color of the map (day, night, auto) and the present location mark (red, yellow).

1 Press the **É** button.

2 Select **System Setting** from the drop-down menu and press the **Ä** button.

3 Change the settings. **SELECT THE UNIT OF DISTANCE (mi/km)**

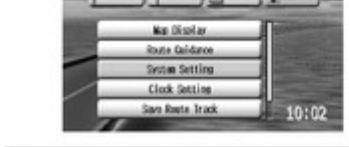
