

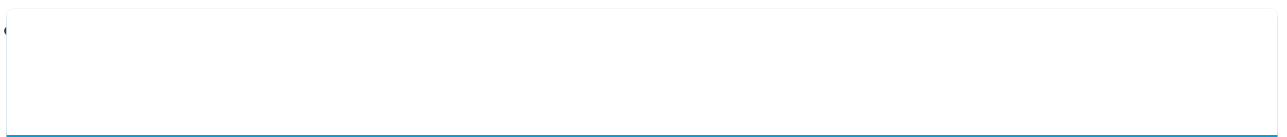

SWITCHING THE TIME DISPLAY

You can select the type of time display to appear on the screen.

■ For DVD videos
Select from "TOTAL ELAPSED", "TITLE REMAIN", "CHAPTER ELAPSED", "CHAPTER REMAIN" and "NO DISPLAY".



■ For CDs
Select from "SINGLE ELAPSED", "SINGLE REMAIN", "TOTAL ELAPSED", "TOTAL REMAIN" and "OFF".

Select from "TOTAL ELAPSED", "TITLE REMAIN", "CHAPTER ELAPSED", "CHAPTER REMAIN" and "NO DISPLAY".

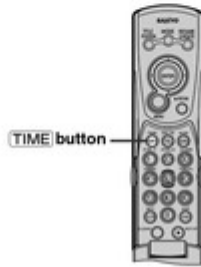
During playback, press the **TIME** button () to select the type of time display. Repeatedly pressing the button changes the type.

Names recorded in a format other than "ISO9960 Level 1" may not be displayed or played back normally. Also, folder names and file names recorded with symbols other than the above will not be displayed correctly.

For multi-session, only the last session will be displayed.

720X480 dot images will fit exactly into the unit's screen.

JPG images recorded on CD EXTRA, Active Audio or Mixed CDs will not be displayed.

Up to 179 folders (a total of 655,360 files) can be read by the unit.

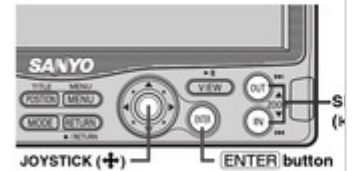

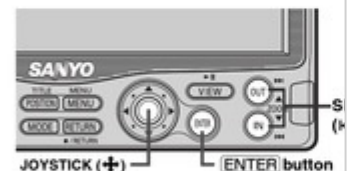
