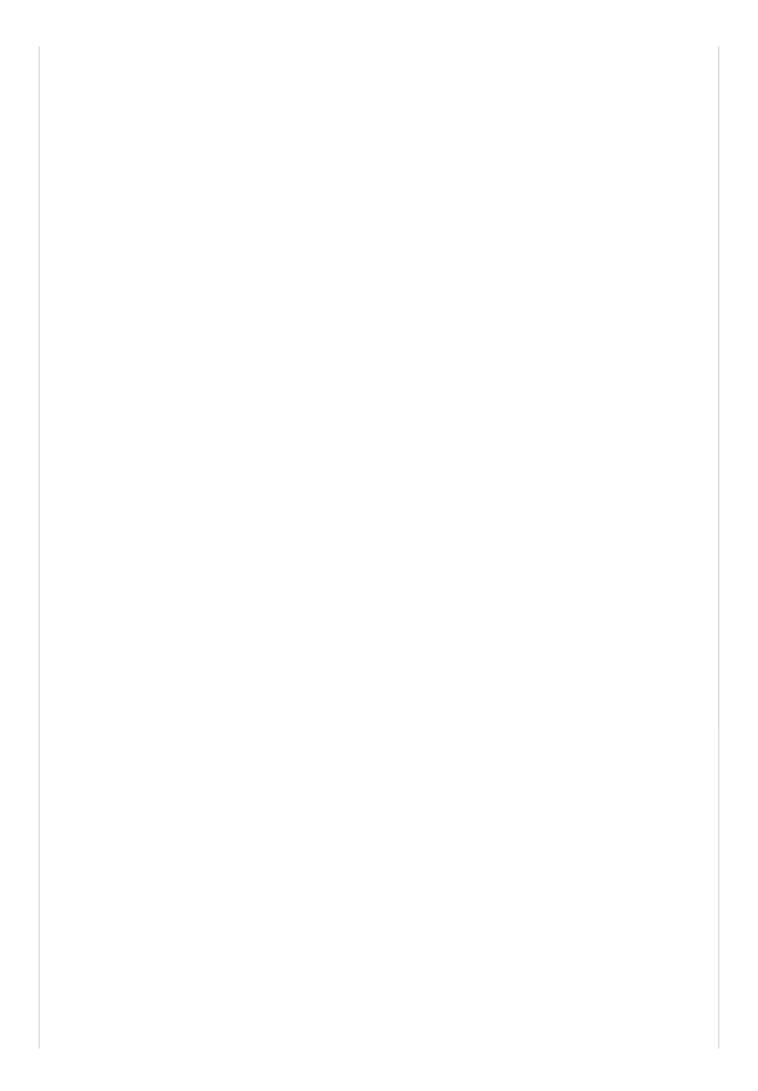

Page 2: Important Safety Instructions

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS All of the following information is important. Be sure to follow the instructions carefully. When using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should always be followed, including the Do not wind the power cord, remote control cord or sensor controller cord around the main unit, following: remote control, sensor controller, or remote control stand.

<u>Page 3</u> IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS WARNING Do not attempt to disconnect the power plug by pulling the cord, but always by holding the power plug and pulling it out. Also, clean the dust off the power plug periodically. Otherwise, electric shock, short circuit or fire may occur.
