Introduction This software allows you to schedule backup jobs, enabling you to copy the content of one or more folders (backup source) to another location (backup destination), see "Modifying the Backup Source" on page 6. The data in the backup folder can be scheduled to regularly update by user-defined intervals.

Introduction Overview of the Main Screen Backup Window Modify Enables you to edit a specific setting of a selected job. Status Details Launches the Job Status window, displaying a job in more detail. Show My Files Displays the location of the backed up files. Backup button: Immediately runs the selected backup job.

Backup Now EZ backs up the source data after the specified amount of time within one of four predetermined intervals.
