

Page 3: Installation

Installation Step 1 : Connecting the Aerial and Power Supply • Connect your aerial cable plug to the rear of the TV set. For further information please consult your local dealer. • Connect the AC power plug to the wall socket (AC100-264 Volts, 50Hz/60Hz). Note: The form of the AC code and AC plug are different with each country.

<u>Page 4</u> Installation Step 2: Battery Installation of the Remote Control Transmitter Use 2 "AAA" 1.5 volt batteries. Be sure batteries are installed correctly. Note: Do not mix old batteries with new ones or mix different type of batteries together. Step 3: Switching on/Plug & Play Let's start! Let's start! This TV set provides a self-automatic tuning system function called "Plug &...
