Page 12 The power switch allows powering ON and OFF your ASUS 1225/ R252 Series and recovering from standby mode. Press the switch once to turn ON and hold it to turn OFF your ASUS 1225/R252 Series. The power switch only works when the display panel is opened.

<u>Page 13</u> Power Indicator The power indicator lights when the ASUS 1225/R252 Series is turned ON and blinks slowly when the ASUS 1225/R252 Series is in the Suspend-to-RAM (Sleep) mode. This indicator is OFF when the ASUS 1225/R252 Series is turned OFF.

<u>Page 14</u> This is only applicable on models with built-in wireless LAN/ Bluetooth (on selected models). When the built-in wireless LAN/Bluetooth is enabled, this indicator lights. Capital Lock Indicator When this indicator lights up, it indicates that the keyboard is in capital lock mode. ASUS 1225/R252 Series...

Page 15: Bottom Side

ASUS 1225/R252 Series. The bottom side may vary in appearance depending on model. The bottom of your ASUS 1225/R252 Series can get very hot.
