

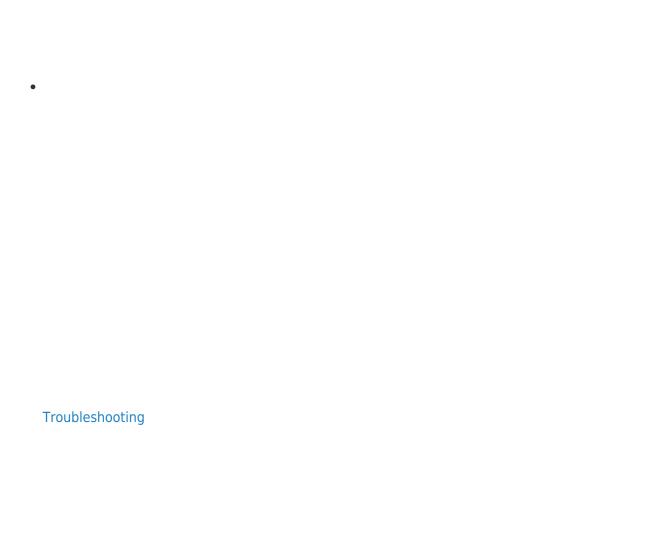



Page 4: Starting Your Washer

NOTE: In wash water temperatures colder than $70^{\circ}F$ ($21^{\circ}C$), 3. (OPTIONAL) Add Liquid Fabric Softener. detergents do not dissolve well. Soils can be difficult to NOTE: Your washer/dryer does not come with a fabric remove. Some fabrics can retain wear wrinkles and have softener dispenser installed.

Page 5: Dryer Use

DRYER USE Loading Load clothes loosely into the dryer. Do not pack the dryer. Allow space for clothes to tumble freely. The following charts show examples of balanced loads that would allow for proper tumbling. LARGE CAPACITY DRYER Heavy Work Mixed Load Towels Delicates...

Page 6: Washer/Dryer Care

WASHER/DRYER CARE Cleaning Your Washer Cleaning the Lint Screen Use a soft, damp cloth or sponge to wipe up any spills such as Clean the lint screen before each load. A screen blocked by lint detergent or bleach from the outside of your washer.

Service calls to correct the installation of your washer/dryer, to instruct you how to use your washer/dryer, or to replace house fuses, reset circuit breakers, correct house wiring, plumbing or venting or to replace owner accessible light bulbs. Heavy 4 in. (10.2 cm) metal exhaust vent must be used.
