

Page 10: Chapter 1 - The Grand Tour

The Grand Tour Your wireless telephone brings mobility and productivity to office telephones. Greater call access cuts down on "telephone tag" delays, and its compact design makes it easy to take with you. The wireless telephone was designed and engineered to provide reliability, long life, and outstanding performance.

Installation This chapter describes installation procedures, including charging the batteries for your wireless telephone. Important!
