

Getting To Know Your Machine Precautions Stop operation immediately if your machine produces smoke, excessive heat, unusual noise, or smell, or if water is spilt onto the machine. These conditions can cause fire. Immediately switch Off and unplug the machine, and contact your service representative. Do not disconnect or reconnect the machine while it is on.
